Rags 2 Riches

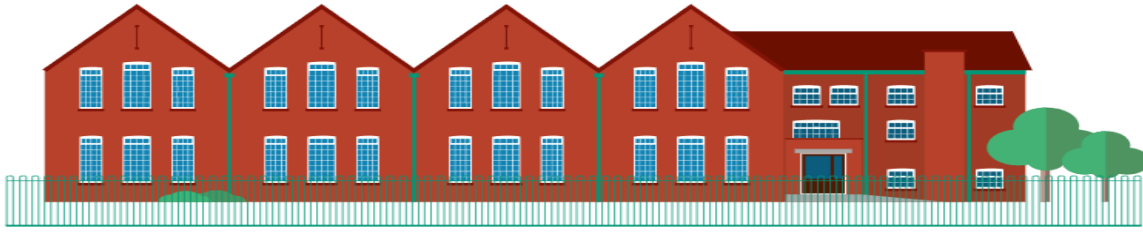
