## Sherwood Area Partnership AIM courses

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## Information for schools and parents:

SAP would like to support targeted parents by helping them complete a **free qualification in** *Children and Young People's Mental Health.* The benefits would be two-fold, firstly parents will be able to apply their learning to their own family life and secondly, they will gain a qualification (online level 2 accredited course equivalent to a GSCS grade C) that can help them develop their own career.

SAP's role is to facilitate parents accessing the training by providing a space and regular dates for sessions. We will be available to work with parents who might struggle with the technology or some of the course content. We will also be able help those who lack confidence and would rather work in a group where there is someone who can help them if they need it.

The intention is to run the sessions from **the SAP base at Sherwood Junior School** on **Wednesday afternoons from 1pm-2:30pm week commencing Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> Feb.** Tea and coffee will be provided along with the chance to chat with a member of the SAP Team.

Parents would need to **bring a device** with them to complete the course on, this can be a tablet or a laptop, but not a phone. We will also need parents to bring **headphones** to the sessions as they will be able to work at their own pace through the training. All the information and resources needed to complete the work are provided by AIM so there are no hidden costs. Parents can work through the course at home, in addition to the sessions we run to facilitate their learning. If parents need help in accessing a device or headphones, could schools please support them to do this as SAP do not have these to lend and will rely on parents bringing them to the session.

## We can provide **space for 8 parents** at a time.

Parents would need to be aware that they have 12 weeks to complete the course and that they could be liable to pay non-completion fee of around £150 if they didn't complete it. However, there are circumstances when the fee is waived.

**The only criteria you must meet to be eligible, is:** Aged 19 or over on or before 31st August 2023 Have lived in the UK/EU for 3+ years Not already on a Government funded course

We are trialling this in the Spring Term in the hope that it is something that has a positive impact for our children and parents.
