Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to you ahead of next week's residential (Wednesday 29th – Friday 31st March) with some reminders about the arrangements.

- Pupils need to arrive at school at 7:30am where they will make their way to the lower hall. We will be departing school promptly at 8:00am.
- Any medication will need to be handed to a member of staff in its original packaging (with the prescription label visible if appropriate). The administration instructions will be checked with you at this point.
- Pupils may bring some treats with them (sweets, crisps etc..). However, Robinwood is a nut-free site and kindly requests that anything containing nut products is not brought onto the premises.
- Pupils will need a drink and snack for the journey. This needs to be packed in a separate bag to their luggage.
- Pupils will not require any money.
- We will be stopping for a comfort break enroute. This will be an opportunity for pupils to have their drink and snack.
- Pupils will be provided with lunch upon arrival at the site.
- Pupils should not bring aerosols with them; roll on deodorant is recommended.
- Pupils will need two pairs of shoes (both must be suitable for the outdoors).
- Pupils will need sufficient clothing for all weathers (including wet).
- Pupils should not bring any electronic items with them (including mobile phones). Robinwood also requests that no cameras, including disposable ones, are brought onto the site in order to adhere to their safeguarding policy.

- Pupils may bring books to entertain them during the journey.
- Staff will take plenty of photographs during the visit and these will be shared with you.
- We will keep in touch with you via the text messaging service.
- We will be departing Wrexham at 2:00pm and will notify you of our ETA.
