The timetable is as follows:

Tuesday 9 May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paper 1: questions</li> <li>Paper 2: spelling</li> </ul>
Wednesday 10 May	English reading
Thursday 11 May	Mathematics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paper 1: arithmetic</li> <li>Paper 2: reasoning</li> </ul>
Friday 12 May	Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

- Pupils will need to arrive at school at 8:35am each morning. They will make their way to the upper hall for registration.
- They will be provided with breakfast (a bacon/sausage cob or a bagel) before the tests begin.
- Pupils have been asked to bring their revision cards with them (they have these for grammar and maths).
- Please could you make sure that they have a water bottle with them each day.
- They may still come to school dressed in their PE kits on Thursday.
- We have optimised the conditions in which the tests are taken and therefore we will be administering the assessments in small groups during the course of the day.

- If your child is feeling unwell during the week, please contact school to discuss this.
