
World Book day



Did you know...?

- A child who is 10 minutes late misses 32 hours a year of lost education
- A child who misses 1 day a week loses 2 months a year of education
- Half a day a week missed throughout school life equates to 1 full year of lost education

DID YOU KNOW? Research tells us that pupils who miss between 10% and 20% of school (that's 19 to 38 days per year) stand only a 35% chance of achieving five or more good GCSEs, compared to 73% of those who miss fewer than 5% of school days!
