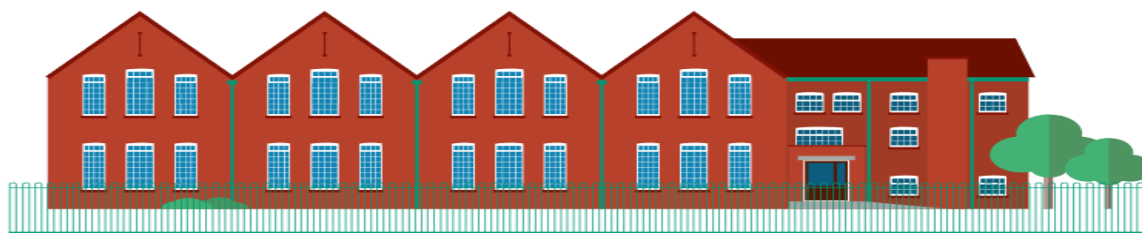
Children in Need
