Building Works

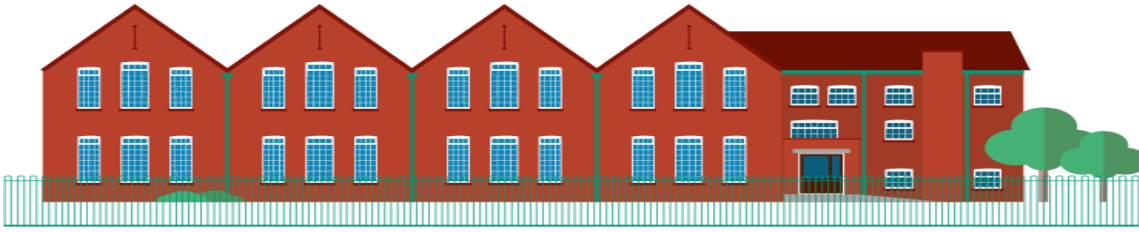
