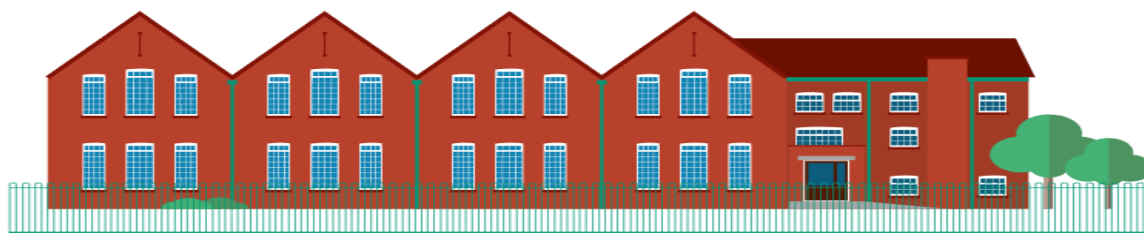


Scooters and Bikes
