The qualifications are completed within a 6–12 week period at your own leisure. They are equivalent to a GCSE Grade C. You can do as many as you like, however you can only do one at a time.

The only criteria you must meet to be eligible, is:

Aged 19 or over on or before 31st August 2023;

Have lived in the UK/EU for 3+ years; Not already on a Government funded course.

drink. The pizza is from The Windmill Fish Bar so it is extra tasty! The theme is to wear something red.


