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School Dinners

As you are aware, children have pre-ordered school dinners in the morning and been given a coloured band which signifies which of our three options for dinner they have chosen.

However, as our numbers in school increase, we are finding that it is taking a long time to get all the children through for dinner and they are having less time to play outside.

We have therefore decided to trial the system used by most schools in the area and offer children their meals on a first come, first served basis. Foundation and Key Stage One children will always be allowed through first, with years 3 – 6 taking it in turns on a rolling basis. There will always be a hot option available for your child but those going into dinner last may not get their first choice. However, they may get the option of seconds!

We have been trialing this idea for a couple of weeks and it seems to be working well. Our school chef has a very good idea of numbers and what the children like and don't like so the children shouldn't really notice a difference apart from the fact they are getting their dinner quicker.
