When is my child starting ...

My child is currently in Birklands Nursery and will still be Nursery age in September... - Starts school on Tuesday 3rd September and continues with their normal hours (could be mornings/some full-days/full-time). If you are wanting to increase hours, please let Miss Stretton know.

My child is currently in Birklands Nursery and will be Reception age in September... - Starts school full-time on Tuesday 3rd September.

My child is currently in at an outside provider and will start in Reception in September... - Starts school full-time on Tuesday 3rd September.

My child starts in at Birklands as a Nursery child in September (should have already been contacted by Miss Stretton)

- Follows a settling in process that starts week beginning 9th September.

What to expect from the first few weeks ...

For the two weeks, children will be split into two groups for registration purposes, consisting of a mix of Nursery and Reception age children. They will spend time with all of their peers in the unit and all members of staff.

After the first two weeks and getting to know the children, the Reception staff will discuss groupings and place your child into Robin or Puffin Group. Friendships will be considered but it is important to remember that the children spend lots of time together, across both classrooms, throughout the school day.

8:35am	The front gates open and children are welcome to help themselves to a bagel before the start of the school day. Children will be invited into the classroom between 8:35am – 8:45am. Start of the morning session for Nursery age children.
11:50am	End of the morning session for Nursery age children – collection from same door as mentioned above.
11:55am-12:40pm	Lunch
3:10pm	End of the school day

Tapestry

We use an online learning journey called 'Tapestry' to share our learning experiences in school. You will need to fill out a consent form (in the new starter pack) so that your child can be added to Tapestry and photos can be shared.

Remember to login to Tapestry regularly to see what your child has been doing at school. Please put your own observations on too; it would be amazing to see all the brilliant learning and exciting things that your child does whilst at home!!

TUESDAY - Any children new to Birklands will attend the morning session and stay for lunch (9:00am-1:00pm). Please come to the Main Reception and you will be directed towards the EYFS Unit; you will be directed towards the EYFS Unit; you will also collect your child from here at 1:00pm.
