



Dear Parent/Carers,

As you are no doubt aware, Government guidelines relating to Covid have changed this week. With this in mind, I thought I would clarify our expectations around Covid.

Anyone with symptoms should take a PCR test, stay at home and follow government guidance if positive.

From today, the government have removed the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test. However, adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least five full days, and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received two negative test results on consecutive days. We would expect our children to follow these guidelines.

This will be reviewed as we approach April 1st as the Government have suggested that the guidelines will change again at this point.
