Dear parents and carers,

Our school has been successful in our recent application to join the free breakfast club programme. Schools across the country are being funded by the Government to provide access to a free, universal breakfast club for all primary-age pupils, from Reception to Year 6.

From the first day of Autumn Term, Tuesday 1st September 2026, we will be delivering a free universal breakfast club.

The breakfast club will start on Tuesday 1st September and will run each school day from 8:15am to 8:45am on the school site. Children will be offered a choice of breakfast items, including cereal, fruit and toast. This provision will be free of charge and will replace the school's previous breakfast offer delivered through the National School Breakfast Programme (NSBP)

Therefore, from 1st September, bagels will no longer be provided to children on arrival at school. Instead, children wishing to access a free breakfast should attend the breakfast club between 8:15am and 8:45am.

To ensure that sufficient food is available each day, all children wishing to access this provision can be booked onto the breakfast club in advance. Advance bookings will enable the school to accurately plan and cater for the expected number of children attending each morning.

Children requiring childcare from 7:30am will still need to be booked onto the school's wraparound breakfast club provision, which will continue to operate as normal and will remain chargeable in line with the current arrangements.

The breakfast club will provide a welcoming start to the school day and ensure that all children have access to a healthy breakfast before lessons begin.

We would like you to fill out a questionnaire to help us find out your views about your child or children attending the free breakfast club.
