Dear Parents and Carers.

We would like to share some important updates regarding staffing and teaching arrangements in Key Stage 1 (KS1).

Firstly, we are delighted to welcome Mr Agar, who will be working in Dove Class, enabling Miss Fox to carry out her role as Acting Deputy Head and Safeguarding Lead. This change ensures that the high-quality teaching and support is maintained. Miss Fox will continue to play an instrumental role in the teaching of Dove Class and in overseeing the KS1 corridor as a whole.

In addition, from next week, we will be introducing a new approach for Maths and English: children will work in their respective year groups for these subjects (pure Year 1 or Year 2), allowing us to tailor learning more precisely to their academic needs. The teachers leading these sessions are the familiar KS1 staff already known to your children: Miss Fox, Mr Agar, Mrs Breedon and Miss Lounds.

Your child will be informed on Friday 21st November which teacher they will have for these sessions, and this will also be communicated with you via our text messaging service. Aside from the Maths and English lessons, children will remain in their original registration group (Jay, Dove or Magpie), where they will continue to be taught by their usual class teacher. Please note that your child's current class teacher is your first point of contact.
