

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may be aware the teacher strike days for next week will be Wednesday the 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday the 16<sup>th</sup> of March. I will be asking that if you do borrow a magnet, they are returned to school on Friday the 17<sup>th</sup> of March as they are part of our classroom provision.
