

Lockdown Restriction: After-school clubs

Dear parent/carers

The government guidance associated with the new lockdown was only published late yesterday.

Having read the documents, yesterday evening I am informing you that under the current lockdown restrictions the school will need to put on hold all after-school clubs, apart from our wrap-around care, that is offered to working parents.

The restrictions state:

Out-of-school activities (including wraparound care) may continue to operate if their primary purpose is providing childcare, to enable parents to go into work. All other out of school activities, not being primarily used by parents for this purpose, should close for face-to-face provision for the duration of the national restrictions.

The impact on our school is that during the current lockdown the following will not take place:

- Phonics after-school sessions with Mrs Nelson held on a Monday and Tuesday
- Phonic after-school sessions with Mrs Norman held on a Thursday
- After-school sports4Kids sessions held on a Thursday
- Dance club with Miss Middleton, held on a Tuesday

Parents who need to access our after-school wrap around care can continue to do so, if they have no other alternative child-care. This should be booked in advance via our school web site.

I apologise for the late notice. I am sure you can appreciate that the guidance is changing constantly and is not always provided well in advance.
