PE

Times Tables

It is vital that pupils have a secure knowledge of multiplication facts, we therefore strongly encourage children to practise their times tables at home. This can be done on 'Times Table Rockstars' (log in details are in the back of reading diaries).

Reading

Please read with your child at home at least **five** times a week and record this in your child's reading diary. It is essential that pupils are encouraged to read at home to develop their vocabulary, fluency and writing.

Each child has been given a targeted book which is pitched to their reading ability. Children will progress through these phases as their fluency develops. Please ensure that reading diaries are brought into school each day.
