Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to share some exciting news about an upcoming development that will significantly enhance our school environment and enrich the daily experiences of our pupils.

After a great deal of planning and preparation, we will soon begin a makeover of the Key Stage 2 playground, with building work scheduled to commence on Monday 20th April and continue for approximately 3 - 4 weeks. This project has been a long time in the making, and we are thrilled to see it finally coming to life.

The redesigned playground will offer a zoned approach to outdoor provision, including:

- A multi-use games area (MUGA)
- Two active play areas
- A shaded area for quieter play and reflection
- An outdoor classroom
- A performance stage

I am sure you will agree that these additions will greatly enhance our pupils' school experience, supporting physical activity, creativity, collaboration and learning beyond the classroom.

During the construction period, there will be some temporary changes to drop-off and pick-up arrangements to ensure everyone's safety while work is underway.

From Monday 20th April:

- All Key Stage 2 pupils will enter school via the main entrance in the morning
- At the end of the day:
 - Year 5 and Year 6 pupils will leave through the main entrance
 - Year 3 and Year 4 pupils will exit via their usual stairwell

Staff will be available to support pupils and families during these changes. We kindly ask for your patience and cooperation while these adjustments are in effect.

We are incredibly excited about this development and the lasting benefits it will bring to our pupils. Thank you, as always, for your continued support as we work to provide the very best learning environment for our children.
