The timetable is as follows:

Date	Activity
Monday 11 May 2026	English grammar, punctuation and spelling Papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 12 May 2026	English reading
Wednesday 13 May 2026	Mathematics Papers 1 and 2
Thursday 14 May 2026	Mathematics Paper 3

- Pupils will need to **arrive at school at 8:35am** each morning – please ensure they are on time. They will make their way to the upper hall for registration.
- **Breakfast will be provided** each morning (a bacon/sausage cob or a bagel) before the tests begin.
- Pupils have been asked to bring their **revision cards** with them (they have these for *grammar* and *maths*) – please check they have them in their bags.
- Please could you make sure that they have a **water bottle** with them each day.
- Pupils may wear **PE kit** next week on test days if they are more comfortable.

We have optimised the conditions in which the tests are taken and therefore we will be administering the assessments in small groups during the course of the day.

If your child is feeling unwell during the week, please contact school at the earliest opportunity to discuss this.

We are immensely proud of the hard work and dedication that Year 6 have displayed this year towards all aspects of their learning; the progress that they have made is nothing short of phenomenal.
