THAMES RIVER CRUISE

This cruise along the Thames is a great way to see some of the major sites of the city. We recommend groups take the cruise from Westminster to Tower which takes in Westminster, Big Ben, Somerset House, London Eye, Oxo Tower, The Tate Modern, St Paul's Cathedral, London Bridge, Tower Bridge and the Tower. This 40-minute cruise packs in many of London's major sites.





WEST END PERFORMANCE - WICKED

Whatever your study aims, a West End show is a great opportunity to reward those on school trips to London with a thrilling night at the theatre. Many shows in the West End, known as 'Theatreland' have been running non-stop since the first time they premiered. Here you will see Wicked, a 2003 musical based on the 1995 novel Wicked focused on the witches from the Land of Oz.





SCIENCE MUSEUM

The Science Museum is the most visited science and technology museum in Europe. There are over 15,000 objects on display, including world-famous objects such as the Apollo 10 command capsule and Stephenson's Rocket.

The large range of interactive galleries brings to life some of the very first scientific principles and contemporary science debates.

Following my recent correspondence regarding the proposed Year 5 visit to London, I am delighted to announce that the level of interest means that it is viable and will therefore be going ahead.

I would like to invite you to a meeting on Friday 4th October to discuss the arrangements for the visit and to answer any questions that you may have. This will take place in Nightingale classroom straight after school (3:15pm). If you are unable to attend this, I am more than happy to speak to you at a mutually convenient time.

The details of the visit are as follows:

London Thursday19th June – Friday 20th June 2025 Cost to parents £200

Please note that the cost of this trip been heavily subsidised by school – the total cost per child is £277; we are paying £77pp in order to keep it as reasonably priced as possible for our families. The price includes private coach transport for the duration of the visit, overnight accommodation, an evening meal on night one and breakfast and lunch on day two, a cruise on The Thames, tickets to a West End Show and entry to The Science Museum and The Natural History Museum.
