Our Christmas Dinner will take place on Wednesday 11th December. The menu is as follows:

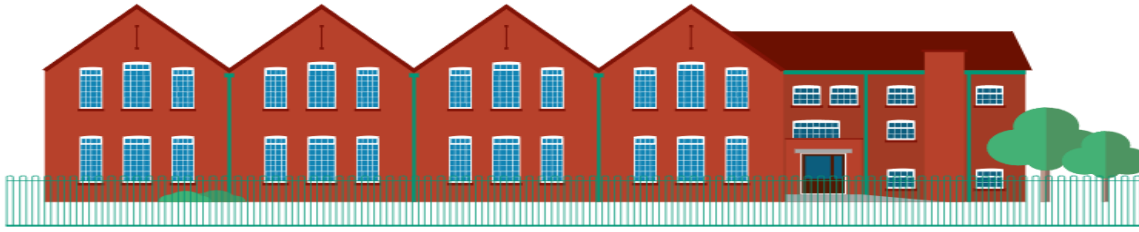
Roast chicken with stuffing and gravy or cauliflower cheese
