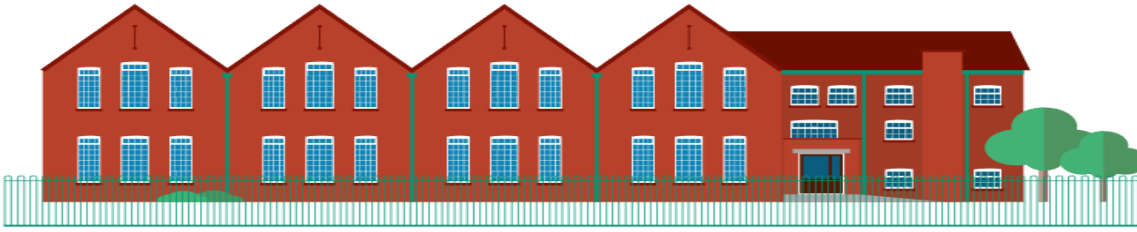

## Asda – Cashpots for Schools

As a school we are participating in the Cashpot for Schools initiative running at Asda. 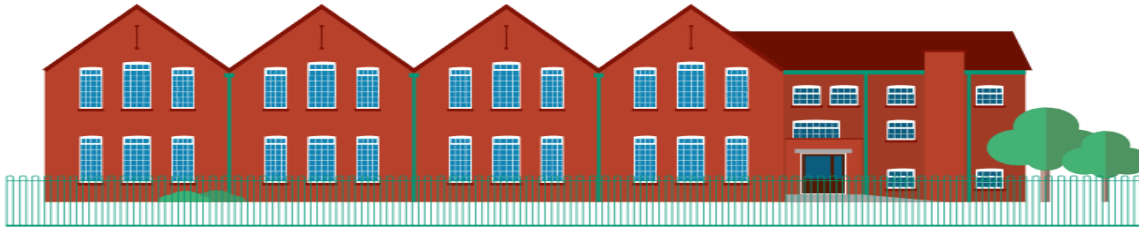
