PE

Times Tables

It is vital that pupils have a secure knowledge of multiplication facts, we therefore strongly encourage children to practise their times tables at home. This can be done on 'Times Table Rockstars' (log in details are in reading diaries). Pupils take weekly times table tests to earn badges as they become more fluent.

In June, **year 4 pupils** will complete a statutory multiplication check focusing on speedy recall of all times tables facts.

Home Learning

Each week, pupils will bring home a spelling sound or pattern linked to their learning in school, and will be encouraged to find and practise words that use their sound/ pattern at home. Pupils take part in daily spelling sessions based on the 'Sounds & Syllables' programme, and take a quiz on a Friday.


Reading

Pupils read daily in school, and it is essential that they are encouraged to read at home to develop their vocabulary, fluency skills and writing. It is expected that pupils read at home at least five times a week, and this needs to be recorded in their reading diary (either by the pupil or an adult). I encourage pupils to write in their own diaries to develop their independence.



English – Our learning in reading and writing centres around texts that link to our topics this term.


Summer 1: writing to entertain
