P.E

Books and diaries should be brought into school each day. We change reading books and 100 books on a Friday morning.

Uniform

At the end of last term, we had a large pile of unnamed clothes which had to be disposed of. Please ensure names are in **ALL** items of clothing that are brought into school.

KS1 Trip to Mansfield Museum

As part of our History topic "What Impact did industries have on our local area?", the children will be visiting Mansfield Museum. This exciting educational visit will help the children to explore which local industries there were in the Mansfield area (e.g. Metal Box, Shoe Factory, Mining) and what impacts these had. Each class will be visiting the museum on different days: **Jay Class will be visiting on Tuesday 23rd November.**

This trip will be within the school day, as we aim to leave school at 9.30a.m. and will return by 3.00p.m. Children must wear school uniform and will need a coat. Your child will not need to bring any money. The cost of this trip will be £13.00 per child and this includes the coach, entry to the museum and an educational talk. Please return the completed slip to your class teachers no later than Friday 12th November. All payments should be made via your child's squid account or a transfer to the school's bank account.
